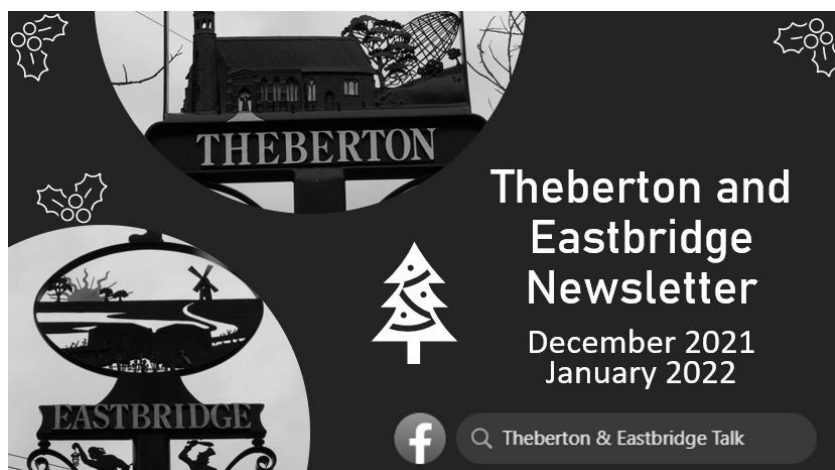

HEDGEROW PLANTING

EASTBRIDGE PLAYING FIELDS

Well done to everyone involved in the planting of the new hedgerow in Eastbridge on Sunday 28th November.



Thanks to all their hard work, a mixed native hedgerow including roses, field maples, dogwoods, crab apples, viburnum, oaks and hawthorn will now start to form a natural border to the playing field.

Please take extra care of the young plants when visiting the field; most saplings are planted along the area shown in the photo but spare stock was also planted near the entrance under the two oak trees and at the boundary with the burial ground.



Property Blight

Update from Stop Sizewell C:

As a busy year draws to a close, Stop Sizewell C would like to thank the community for their incredible support. In the aftermath of the Budget and COP26, these final weeks of the year will see us meeting Ministers, rubbing shoulders with the Business Secretary (see photo) and briefing MPs and members of the House of Lords on the Nuclear Financing Bill currently passing through parliament.
