Remembrance Memorial Service Despite the rain, on Sunday the 12th of November the Remembrance Memorial Service was well attended. Stephen Beaumont read the names of the fallen in both world wars. Two minute silence salute was taken by Steve Nicholls (Army retired). It was heartwarming that all the folks came into church where Tina Neal did a great job running the service with Steve Nicholls reading an emotive poem and Judith Croton giving an interesting talk about our village fallen and the locations of burials home and away. Particularly pleasing was the number of children in attendance at this annual village event.



Stop Sizewell C update Just before the Chancellor's Autumn Statement, Stop Sizewell C went to Westminster with a vibrant digital AdVan to tell Ministers to Cancel Sizewell C. We were joined by Caroline Lucas MP (Green) and Alan Brown MP (SNP), both of whom - along with Liberal Democrat Energy spokesperson Wera Hobhouse - have written to the National Audit Office asking for an early review of Sizewell C's "value for money".

We also took the AdVan with the message "Don't Buy Sizewell C" to a handful of investors that have been named as having a possible interest in Sizewell C: Centrica, the Universities' Superannuation Scheme, Stonepeak and the Emirates' Nuclear Energy Company.
